The IQAC of the college has developed the feedback mechanism commencing with obtaining feedback from the various stakeholders through a structured feedback form. As per the Student Satisfaction Survey for Academic Year: 2021-2022 received from the students have been taken into the Staff Council Meeting dated: 20.02.2023 and the following action has been taken into consideration.

Students are an integral part of institution. Students of an institution form the core of the stakeholders and all the activities undertaken by the institute are focused on creating a barrier free and conducive environment for excelling in their academics. In this regard the institution has provided many facilities for the benefit of students. In order to capture the experiences of students for the academic session 2021-2022, a questionnaire of 20 parameters has been framed and forwarded online. The questionnaire of the survey includes 20 questions to which responses are given anonymously by the students of the institution with the help of Google forms. The survey components include an institute level feedback on infrastructure facilities, academic facilities and teaching-learning experiences. The survey questions include the parameter like facilities, syllabus, faculty, soft skills, employability skills, evaluation process, course outcomes, community service project, short term and long-term internships, student exchange, field visit opportunities, methodology, using ICT tools, extracurricular activities and related activities in the college revealed that the students are highly satisfied.

The outcome of the survey will help to reach the objective of the institution. This will also help to initiate remedial action to improve the facilities whenever and wherever it is required. The result of the survey will provide a base to plan for the future.

Analysis Report:

- Totally 476 students responded to student satisfaction survey.
- The analysis of the survey conducted shows that most of the students were highly satisfied on the teaching and learning process of the institution.
- Students have expressed satisfaction over the syllabus covered in their classes
- At the same time the students are appreciated and highly satisfied with the implementation of learning outcome-based curriculum which includes communication of teacher with students, teaching methodology, seminar works and its follow up made by the faculty throughout the semester.
- They also satisfied and acknowledged the effort put by the faculty in promoting and conducting seminars, workshops especially community service projects, internships and hands on training sessions, interdisciplinary learning programmes implemented in the institution since they are very much helpful to them to see world beyond their prescribed curriculum and also motivating them to learn other object or practical.
- They also expressed their satisfaction and acknowledged the faculty participation in identifying strengths and weaknesses of students and suggest suitable measures through career guidance and counselling sessions.
- Institutional ability in inculcating soft skills, life skills and employment skills among the students to the world of words, teaching with ICT tools by the faculty along with the appropriate teaching pedagogy has been rated high in the survey.
