The discussion was between three groups, First group chose to highlight the positives on improvements in technology, Second group comprised of students who perceived negative impact of AI in Employment and the third group was the neutral group that apprised about both the benefits and challenges of AI in employment. Points discussed in the favour of the topic were like "increase labour productivity by automating routine tasks while expanding employee skills and increasing the value of work". This can lead to increased job satisfaction and productivity. The views against the motion were "that there might be negative impact on the jobs and employment scenario AI applications may execute key tasks currently performed

by humans, which could lower labour demand, leading to lower wages and reduced hiring ".

Lastly, we tried to draw attention of the students to summarise and conclude the GD highlighting all the important points' discussed by all the groups.


