The department of Zoology is one of the prestigious departments of this college and it started in 1950. The department is equipped with two laboratories & and one museum. Museum contains different scientific equipment and animal collections. Animal collections include animals fixed in fluids, dried, specially prepared animals, stuffed animals, skeletons and articles made from horns, bones, shells etc. All these articles are arranged and displayed systematically in glass cases and racks. Displayed collections are shown not only to zoology students but also open to students of other courses & students of other colleges. Museum also contains around 200 charts and 200 slides. The slides are mounted with microscopic animal, larvae and sections of various tissues. All these items are used for practical study or may be shown at a lecture. Microscopic specimens are examined by means of regular and binocular magnifying glasses and microscopes. The collection includes several specimens of various invertebrate and vertebrate phyla.
