MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter referred to as "Agreement") is made and executed on 25th day of January, 2022 at Kadapa.

BETWEEN

Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa functioning under the aegis of Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh, situated at Near New Collectorate, RIMS Road, Kadapa-516004 and represented by Dr. G. Ravindranath, Principal, hereafter referred as "**Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa**" Who is duly authorized to sign and execute the MoU as FIRST PART.

AND

Suraj Krishna Greenaries, an authorized agency of ITC having its principal office situated at D.NO: 37/1052-A1, Nehru Nagar, Kadapa-516002. Phone Number: 8309657266 and represented by Sri. K.Rama Chandraiah, Managing Partner, here after referred as "**Suraj Krishna**" as SECOND PART.

Whereas **Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa** is conventional Educational Institution and desires to have a training/creating awareness "Solid Waste Management" to their students.

Whereas **Suraj Krishna Greenaries** is engaged in the business of "Solid Waste Management". The objective is to create awareness on by establishing "**Swachh Wealth out of Waste (WOW) Club**" in the college and to purchase the "Solid Waste Generated in the College".

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

This is an agreement for a synergic alliance between Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa and Suraj Krishna Greenaries for the Social Cause of Environment Protection by Recycling of Dry Waste Paper.

Time period: This MOU shall be for a period of 3 years from date of signing MoU.

And whereas the First and Second parties agree to enter into a partnership under the following terms and conditions.

Roles and Responsibilities of Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa :

1. Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa will provide Segregated Solid Waste (Dry and Wet Waste) on time fixed by both parties.
2. Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa will give any kind of Paper Waste to Suraj Krishna Greenaries at price agreed mutually. Suraj Krishna Greenaries will pay as rates mentioned below:

White Waper & News Paper: **Rs.12/kg.**

Carton Boxes: **Rs. 2/kg.**

3. Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa shall form "Swachh WOW Club" in the college with Student Volunteers and adopt nearby Schools or Colonies to promote Source Segregation through Student Volunteers.
4. Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa shall motivate their students to bring dry recyclables paper/waste material from their home and donate to "Swachh WOW Club" initiative.
5. Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa shall send their students for Internship under "Swachh WOW Club" initiative.

Roles and Responsibilities of Suraj Krishna Greenaries:

1. Suraj Krishna Greenaries (ITC-WOW team) will impart training to the students and housekeeping staff on source segregation and through them inculcate the habit of source segregation among the other students.
2. Suraj Krishna Greenaries will collect dry recyclable waste and old records from Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa and bring to the Hub for sorting and baling of the material collected and dispatch to recycling industries.
3. Suraj Krishna Greenaries shall coordinate with ITC Ltd and undertake necessary measures for dispatch of the sorted recyclables for recycling at its own cost.
4. Suraj Krishna Greenaries will make payment to Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa directly into their accounts for the dry recyclable paper waste collected against the accurate weight.
5. The payment shall be made not more than 15 days from the date of payment request raised by the college.
6. Suraj Krishna Greenaries on the request of Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa may provide New Notebooks and Stationery against the value of dry recyclable paper lifted.
7. Suraj Krishna Greenaries & Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa will jointly organize awareness/training programmes, seminars, workshops for staff/students.

Performance of Obligations

1. The details laid out in this MOU, notwithstanding the essence and spirit of this MOU is an understanding between Government College for Men (Autonomous), Kadapa and Suraj Krishna Greenaries.
2. Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing in the English language and shall be delivered personally or sent by way of e-mail to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its address set out in this contract or such other address as either party may specify by notice in writing to other.

Execution of this Agreement shall be deemed to be

1. 2. An undertaking by both the parties not to provide any benefit, either in cash or kind to any officer/employee/relative/associate of any officer or employee of either party as reward or consideration either for entering into this MOU or other matter relating to this Agreement.
3. The MoU does not hold any legal/financial/administrative consequences after being terminated by both the parties or at the behest of any of the parties.

Amendments

This Agreement and the schedules together constitute a complete and exclusive understanding of the terms of the Agreement between the Parties on the subject hereof and no amendment or modification hereto shall be valid and effective unless agreed to by all the Parties hereto and evidenced in writing.


Terms & Conditions of MoU:

1. The duration of this MoU will be for Three years from the date this MoU has come into effect as specified in the first paragraph and can be extended for another two years with the mutual written consent of both the institutions.
2. Both parties have to appoint a representative to initiate and execute the activities under this MOU.
